




SAFETY SIGNS AND POSTERS' VIEWING DISTANCE

The use of safety signs are very crucial in any work environment. The main factor of using safety signs is to prevent possible injury and to ensure the welfare of employees on the dangers and hazards present in their workplace. A workplace that has a sufficient sign helps protect employees against possible risks and will prevent or lessen accidents.

Safety signs must be in appropriate size to view without straining our eyes when communicating safety messages to employees. You must consider the environment, lighting and viewing distance of the sign to suit your application.



Safety signs positioned at High Level Location are intended for all users of a building. Positioning the sign at the high level will allow all individuals with different height to see it, and shall be installed at a height above 1.8m. Signs located at the Intermediate Location Level are intended for the user of the identified equipment, at a height of between 1.2 and 1.5m.
